WATERTOWN, WI – The Watertown Humane Society is excited and honored to announce it has received a \$3,000 grant from the Green Bay Packers Foundation during the last quarter of 2025. The grant was awarded in response to a proposal submitted by Lisa, Community Coordinator, and Heather, Executive Director, for a project titled Bridging the Pawprint Trail: Investing in Technology to Improve Access, Efficiency, and Animal Welfare Education. Watertown Humane Society was awarded the full amount requested to enhance technology throughout the shelter.

Funding from the Green Bay Packers Foundation will support the purchase of:

- A television for the shelter’s meeting room to provide animal welfare education for visiting groups
- A laptop and mobile cart to be used by staff as a mobile reporting station for animal care notes
- A lobby television to showcase adoptable animals and promote upcoming shelter events
- Lobby kiosks to make clinic forms, adoption applications, volunteer applications, and other resources immediately accessible to visitors

“These improvements will allow us to better serve our community, streamline daily operations, and enhance the experience for everyone who walks through our doors—most importantly, the animals in our care,” said Heather, Executive Director of Watertown Humane Society.
